Background

The Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act (RFCTLARR), 2013 that replaced the colonial Land Acquisition Act, 1894 and combined both land acquisition and R & R under one umbrella became effective from 1st January, 2014. The compensation and R & R norms were also made applicable to the legislations in the Schedule IV of the Act from 1st January 2015. These included the national highway projects, the mining projects and railway projects

The 2013 Act provides that states can enact any law/policy to enhance or add the entitlements enumerated under the Act which confers higher compensation and R&R. Perception of potential delay in acquisition of land through the new legislation paved the way for development of alternative policies to land acquisition. Some of the important innovative alternatives that has emerged include **land pooling, land purchase and land lease**. Bihar became the first state that issued guidelines on land taking through land lease instead of acquisition as per section 104 of RFCTLARR Act, 2013. Government of Andhra Pradesh come out with an innovative land pooling for assembling land for its new Capital city project. Land pooling policies are also being made use of to procure land for infrastructure projects in few other states. State governments like Telangana, Madhya Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal, Maharashtra, Karnataka, Orissa and Chhattisgarh framed land purchase policies. The states of Gujarat and Telangana also received Presidential assent for their RCTLARR (Amendment) Acts.

About the Course

What are the implementation experiences of the RFCTLARR Act, 2013 and alternative land assembly measures (land acquisition, pooling and purchase) in different states? How has land acquisition progressed in the Schedule IV legislations (National Highways Act, 1956; Coal Bearing Areas (Acquisition and Development) Act, 1957, etc)? How are R & R provisions in the 2013 Act interpreted and implemented? How can we ensure that SIA becomes a powerful decision making tool as conceptualised by the 2013 Act? How can SIA surveys be made more accurate, effective and how can these surveys be monitored? What needs to be done for faster acquisition of land? What are the other national and international developments that merit the attention of all stakeholders dealing with land and R & R issues?

The implementation data on RFCTLARR Act has now been compiled for various states. There is also a comprehensive study undertaken by CMLARR on various alternative land procurement mechanisms in the country. The much appreciated *ASCI Annual Course on Effective LARR - The RFCTLARR Act and Beyond* would comprehensively discuss the above developments. In the light of the implementation of the new land acquisition law and alternative land assembly mechanisms, the program aims at providing a roadmap for time-bound and efficient land assembly. The program would cover the developments in various states, judicial interpretation, alternative land procurement mechanisms vis. land purchases, land pooling etc. The 5-day Annual LARR Program will provide a learning platform for a comprehensive understanding of the national and international

developments in LARR besides sharing experiences from different states in land acquisition/alternative mechanisms for land assembly.

CMLARR, ASCI

Established with the support of the World Bank and AusAID, CMLARR has been leading the capacity building interventions for LARR specialist officers in India and in the South Asian region. Among the prominent international assignments successfully completed by the Centre include the Joint Certification programs with National Research Centre for Resettlement, China, Module on "Formulating a National Resettlement Policy" for the Ministerial delegation from Government of Uganda; Customised Course on Improved Management of LARR for Senior Officials of Government of Egypt; Support for reforms in LARR and developing of SIA Guidelines for Govt of Egypt, International South-South learning event on R & R and Benefit Sharing; advisory guidance to University of Peradeniya, Sri-Lanka for improving their LARR Course, support for Training of Trainers Workshops organized by World Bank for South Asian countries etc.

CMLARR has entered into **MoUs with Department of Land Resources, Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India** for effective planning, implementation and monitoring of the Laws/Policies relating to Land Acquisition and Associated Rehabilitation/Resettlement of the Affected/Displaced people. **The Centre has also signed an MoU with National Research Centre for Resettlement, Hohai University, China** to support cooperation and create research network for effective management of social issues in infrastructure development through Joint Certification program/international programs. In the mining sector, CMLARR has been partnering Coal India Ltd for Customised courses and has also signed an **MoU with Indian Institute of Coal Management (IICM)** for enhanced cooperation in the area of Land Acquisition, Resettlement and Rehabilitation (LARR) and Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) etc. The Centre has conducted customised capacity building programs on the RFCTLARR Act, 2013 for the Governments of Karnataka, Bihar, Tamil Nadu, Punjab and Sikkim. Dealing officers from 20 state governments have also participated in the LARR Courses at ASCI. The Centre has also prepared a comprehensive Courseware on LARR, covering detailed step-wise procedures for LA and R & R in line with the RFCTLARR Act, 2013.

The Centre has developed software applications that will enable hassle free and accurate SIA surveys and templates for effectively conducting and monitoring such studies. The Centre has also prepared a comprehensive manual on LARR covering detailed step-wise procedures for SIA, LA and R & R in line with the RFCTLARR Act.

Participant Profile

State government officials in charge of Land Acquisition and SIA; Executives working in Public and Private Sector Organisations in land acquisition, R & R, environment, CSR and R & R departments.

Training Methods

This 5-day intensive program places emphasis on interactive learning. The highly interactive learning environment combines experience sharing, case studies, role play exercises and lectures cum-discussion. The mix of the methods aims to provide ample opportunity to the participants to learn from the peer group as well as faculty and subject experts.

Venue

The Programme is fully residential and the participants will be accommodated in single air-conditioned rooms in the Bellavista/College Park Campus of the College. The College

does not provide accommodation for the family. Transport between Airport / Railway Station and Campus will be arranged by the College. The College campus is WiFi enabled.

Duration

The Programme duration is from Monday, **9th October, 2017** to Friday, **13th October, 2017**. The participants are expected to arrive a day before the commencement and may leave after the conclusion of the programme.

Program Fee

CMLARR, ASCI, Hyderabad

Administrative Staff College of India (ASCI) was established at Hyderabad on 18 May, 1956 at the initiative of the government and the corporate sector. The College was established on the lines of the Administrative Staff College at Henley-on-Thames in England. The ASCI main campus at Bella Vista, Hyderabad is the erstwhile palace of the Prince of Berar. In 1956, the first Court of Governors (CoG) was constituted under the Chairmanship of Dr. John Mathai, the former Union Finance Minister. General Shrinagesh, on retiring as Army Chief, was the first Principal of ASCI. The academic activities started on 6 December, 1957. The Value statement of ASCI (as per Rig Veda hymn) is, "Let us be together, let us interact together, and may our minds comprehend together".

India has accumulated vast experience in management of Land Acquisition, Resettlement and Rehabilitation (LARR). There was a long felt need for a Regional Centre for capacity building and research in management of LARR in the region. Recognizing the wealth of experience in both operations and policy development in India and ASCI's experience in LARR capacity building interventions, a World Bank-AusAID supported Regional South-South Learning Hub called the **Centre for Excellence in Management of Land Acquisition, Resettlement and Rehabilitation (CMLARR)** was established at ASCI.
